We also process cookies automatically.

What are cookies?

This is actually a small text file that is created by visiting each web page. It is used as a standard tool to store information about how the website is used.

We are thus able to distinguish (but not specify or identify) individual users from each other and tailor the content of the website to specific preferences. Cookies are important. Without them, browsing the web would be much more difficult.

Cookies serve several purposes. We use the following cookies on our website:

Analytical cookies: this type of cookie helps us to improve our website, which in turn benefits you. Analytical cookies on our website are collected by a script from Google Inc., which then anonymises these data. After anonymisation, they are no longer personal data, because anonymised cookies cannot be assigned to a specific user or a specific person. We only work with cookies in anonymised form. Therefore, we cannot determine from the cookies how a particular user has behaved on our website (which pages they have visited, which services they have viewed, etc.) The processing of these cookies can also be refused, see below under the point: THE WAY TO SET COOKIES

We also use the knowledge from these cookies for advertising purposes.

HOW TO SET COOKIES: THE WAY TO SET COOKIES

Just use one of the commonly available internet browsers (e.g. Internet Explorer, Opera, Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome, Safari) with the anonymous browsing function enabled, which will prevent the storage of data about the visited websites, or you can disable the storage of cookies in your browser completely. However, if you also disable the processing of technical and functional cookies, this will prevent some of the functions that help you from working.

Unfortunately, disabling analytical cookies will make it much harder for us to improve our website. To refuse the processing of cookies (with the exception of technical cookies), you can write to us at info.cz@lesaffre.com By refusing the processing of functional and analytical cookies, you will not lose

the ability to access our website, nor will it lead to a refusal of our services. However, by refusing the processing of functional and analytical cookies, you may inadvertently cause our website to not function properly and some of its functions may subsequently be unavailable to you. The overall efficiency and accessibility of our site's features may therefore be limited when browsing our site.

Privacy Policy:

Your personal data are completely safe with us. In order to prevent unauthorised access and misuse of your personal data, we have put in place appropriate measures of both a technical and organisational nature. We care about protecting your personal data. That is why we not only regularly check their security but also continuously improve their protection. All communication between your device and our web servers is encrypted. Login credentials are encrypted and all your data are stored only on servers in secure data centres with restricted, carefully controlled and audited access. We strive to use security measures that provide sufficient security given the current state of technology. The security measures taken are thus regularly updated. Withdrawal of consent: In relation to your personal data, you have in particular the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data at any time, the right to rectify or complete your personal data, the right to request the restriction of their processing, the right to object to or complain about the processing of your personal data, the right to access your personal data, the right to request the transfer of your personal data, the right to be informed of a breach of security of your personal data and, under certain conditions, the right to erasure of certain personal data that we process in relation to you, i.e. the right to be forgotten.

If you contest the accuracy of your personal data, your personal data are processed unlawfully, we no longer need your personal data for processing purposes but you need them for the establishment, exercise or defence of your legal claims, or if you have raised an objection under the previous points, you have the right to have us restrict the processing of your personal data. In this case, we can only process your personal data with your consent (except for the storage or backup of the personal data in question).

If you believe that we are processing your personal data unlawfully, you also have the right to file a complaint with the Office for Personal Data Protection. Cookies that we process:

VISITOR_INFO1_LIVE	A cookie that YouTube sets to measure your bandwidth and determine if you get a new or old player interface.
YSC	This cookie is set by the YouTube video service on YouTube embedded sites to track

	views.
__utma	This is a permanent cookie that expires in 2 years by default and distinguishes between users and sessions. Used to track first visit, last visit, current visit, and number of visits to calculate statistics for new and returning visitors. The cookie is updated every time the data is sent to Google Analytics. Website owners can customize the lifetime of the cookie.
__utmc	Contains the timestamp of the exact moment the visitor leaves the site. This works with __utmb to calculate when you close the browser to calculate how long the visit will take.
__utmz	This cookie tracks the entry point to your website and stores the traffic source, medium, campaign and search term used to land on your site - so Google Analytics can tell site owners where visitors came from when they came to the site. The cookie has a lifespan of 6 months and is updated every time the data is sent to Google Analytics.
__utmt	Used to limit the speed of service requests (limit data collection on high-traffic sites)
__utmb	Used to specify new sessions and visits and expires after 30 minutes. The cookie contains the timestamp of the exact moment the visitor enters the website and is updated every time the data is sent to Google Analytics. Any user activity within 30 minutes will count as one visit, even if the user leaves the site and then returns. A return after 30 minutes will count as a new visit but a returning visitor.
cookieLawInfo-checkbox-necessary	This cookie, set by the GDPR CookieConsent plugin, is used to record the user's consent to cookies in the "Required" category.
cookieLawInfo-checkbox-non-necessary	This cookie is set by the GDPR CookieConsent plugin. The purpose of this cookie is to check

whether the user has given his consent to the use of cookies in the "Unnecessary" category.
